Rhode Island Carriage Days PDS: Janice Meszoely reported that the information for the upcoming Rhode Island Carriage Days Pleasure Show was into the Omnibus and she also passed out copies of the ADS Omnibus listing.

The Rhode Island Federation of Riding Clubs is the caretaker of the Conestoga Wagon. It was recently moved from the Sprague Mansion to Clouds Hill Farm. The Farm will be open and the Wagon will be on display during May, National Carriage Month (dates to be determined), Governors Tourism Day on May 3 and National Tourism Week on May 10<sup>th</sup>. Clouds Hill Victorian House Museum is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit and a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation operating an historic Victorian home located in Warwick, Rhode Island as a museum for the public. The house is an important part of the history of the City of Warwick and the State of Rhode Island. William Smith Slater built it in 1872 for his daughter, Elizabeth Ives Slater, on her marriage to Alfred Augustus Reed, Jr. It has remained in the family since it was built, passing from female to female until reaching the current owner, Anne Holtz.
