Schedule:

10:00 – 12:00 Clinic with harness fitting and carriage fitting. Learn how a harness should fit a horse and what size carriage is appropriate for that horse. Various harnesses will be tried on our volunteer horse and various carts and carriages will be available for inspection. Learn what fits and what does not fit and which harness goes with which carriage. All questions will be gladly answered.

12:00 – 1:00 Pot luck lunch with hot dogs and hamburgers. Bring a dish if you like or a bag of chips, your choice. Soft drinks will be available. Short general meeting of the Rhode Island Driving Club during lunch.

1:00 – 3:00 Clinic for new combined driving navigators and drivers. Learn how the sport of combined driving really works. What the heck is a green card? What are the parts of a marathon and what on earth is that navigator for? Volunteer horse "Cory" and his driver and navigator will drive a mock combined driving course. Again all questions will be answered.

Beverly Willard has offered to scribe, but if someone else is also interested, a split day might be better. A cones course will also be set up for participants to drive after their dressage. The cones course will be judged. The event/clinic will be limited to 20 participants. There will also be a club general meeting there that day from 12:00 to 1:00 with "Burger Bob" cooking hotdogs and hamburgs. Club members are asked to bring potluck sides.
